FINAL TIMETABLE FOR THE REVIEW PROCESS
OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE INTER-PARLIAMENTARY CONFERENCE
FOR THE COMMON FOREIGN AND SECURITY POLICY AND THE COMMON
SECURITY AND DEFENCE POLICY

5 September 2013

Vilnius

The Ad Hoc Review Committee, having convened in the framework of the Inter-Parliamentary Conference for the Common Foreign and Security Policy and the Common Security and Defence Policy on 4–6 September 2013 in Vilnius, agreed on the final timetable for the review process of the Rules of Procedure of the Inter-Parliamentary Conference.

Lithuanian Presidency

1. The Working Group of the Ad Hoc Review Committee submits the proposals from national Parliaments to amend the Rules of Procedure and classifies these proposals into four categories.
2. The Ad Hoc Review Committee examines the proposal for classification and makes note on this at the concluding session of the Inter-Parliamentary Conference.
3. The Ad Hoc Review Committee takes note of the Initial Recommendations by the Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania as the Presidency Parliament and forwards them to the Greek Presidency for further consideration.

Greek Presidency

4. The Working Group meeting in a seminar elaborates a package proposal (February/ March 2014).
5. The Ad Hoc Review Committee considers the package proposal prepared by the Working Group.
6. The Athens Inter-Parliamentary Conference considers the proposals.

Italian Presidency

7. The Ad Hoc Review Committee considers the proposals and submits its recommendations for the final adoption to the Rome Inter-Parliamentary Conference.
8. The recommendations are considered by the Conference of Speakers of EU Parliaments in Rome.
