Dear President,

The Commission would like to thank the Senát for its Opinion on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on a European network of Employment Services, workers' access to mobility services and the further integration of labour market {COM(2014) 6 final}.

The Commission fully supports the remark as regards the need for an increased awareness of the services that EURES can provide and points to Article 7(6) of the Proposal that makes explicit reference to staff and resources necessary to carry out the tasks defined in the proposed Regulation. Additionally, the Proposal envisages the creation of a national hub to allow for an efficient transfer from the national level to the EURES portal of information on job vacancies, job applications and CV's made available by any organisation that is willing to share this information on the EURES portal.

With reference to the schemes for recognition of European professional qualifications, the Commission observes that such schemes advocate the use of the European classification of skills, competences, qualifications and occupations as a vector for a more efficient matching system between job vacancies and job applications.

The points made above are based on the initial proposal presented by the Commission which is currently in the legislative process involving both the European Parliament and the Council at which your government is represented.

The Commission hopes that the above clarifications address the issues raised in your Opinion and looks forward to continuing the political dialogue with the Senát.
