The verification carried out of the proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council on the definition, description, presentation, labeling and protection of geographical indications for flavored wine (Com(2011) 530) in regard of the respect of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality shows that the proposed text contains a number of provisions that are inconsistent with the implied principles.

The main problem is that the proposed regulation gives power to the European Commission to adopt key elements of the legislation by delegated act, which is in contradiction with article 290 of the TFEU, therefore the concerned provisions are in breach of the principle of subsidiarity .
