Registration and Accreditation

The Bulgarian Presidency has implemented an online registration system for all meetings. The DAO can view the accreditation status in the system. Once the process is complete, accredited participants will be issued with a badge that will grant them access to the venue hosting the relevant events. Participants will not be admitted to the venue without the badge. Accreditation is personal and non-transferable. The registration in the hotels will also happen through the accreditation system.

Hotels

Participants are encouraged to book their hotel rooms at their earliest possible convenience in one of the recommended hotels below. Participants are kindly asked to book accommodation directly through the accreditation system.

The Bulgarian Presidency of the Council of the European Union has negotiated a block reservation for all delegates participating in the event. The recommended hotels and negotiated special room rates (per room per night) for the event are available in the accreditation system. Both hotels were selected to be at central and most convenient location for the delegates. Hilton Sofia Hotel is within walking distance to the conference venue and Hotel Marinela Sofia is near the James Bourchier underground station.

All delegates are kindly asked to cover the costs of their own accommodation. The prices include accommodation, rich buffet breakfast and 9 percent VAT. Additional city tax of € 0,67 per person per night and parking fee (if parking is needed) are not included in the price and should be paid separately. Please note that any individual expenses such as telephone, bar drinks, room minibar, laundry, extra paid TV, etc. are not included in the room rate. Therefore, you are kindly asked to make sure such bills are settled before departure.

Travelling and Transfers

Each delegation is kindly requested to cover its costs for transportation to Bulgaria. The delegations are advised to arrive in Sofia by the afternoon of 21 January 2018. All delegates are to organize their own transport to and from Sofia International Airport. Transportation service will be available for the delegates from the hotels to the conference and dinner venues.



By Underground

The Sofia Metro station is located at Terminal 2 at Sofia International Airport. A shuttle bus service free of charge is available from Terminal 1 to Terminal 2. Single ticket for metro and public transport: 1,60 BGN. Tickets can be purchased from Transport Documents Machine at the underground's entrances or by a cashier at the cash-desks of "Metropoliten". Tickets should be validated at the validator located on the barriers to the metro entrance and can be used for entrance to the metro up to 30 minutes after its issuance.

By bus

Buses are available from Terminal 1 and 2. Single tickets for bus lines 84, 184 and 384 can be purchased from the ticket offices of Sofia Urban Mobility Center, located in the Arrivals Hall of Terminal 2 or from the ticket machines at Terminal 1 of Sofia International Airport. Please perforate your single ticket after boarding the vehicle.

By taxi

Taxis are available directly outside the Arrivals Hall at Sofia International Airport 24 hours a day. A taxi service booth is situated in the Arrivals Hall. The price of a taxi service from Sofia Airport to the City centre costs approximately 10-14 BGN (€5-7). The journey time is approximately 30 minutes, depending on traffic. In case a delegation prefers to bring accompanying interpreter, the interpretation mode will be whispering.

Tourism

Bulgaria is proud of its pristine nature and amazing biodiversity, which is preserved in the mountains, parks and nature reserves. The country occupies only 2% of Europe's territory but with more than 40 000 cultural monuments and artefacts, it is in third place in Europe. Seven of them are recognised in the UNESCO List of World Cultural Heritage Sites. This includes prehistoric artefacts, Thracian and Roman heritage, historical monuments from the First and the Second Bulgarian Kingdoms, and architectural landmarks from the Age of Bulgarian Renaissance. As a recognition of its ancient cultural heritage, Plovdiv was selected as 2019 European Capital of Culture.

Traditionally known for its sun, sand and sea, the Bulgarian seaside also offers hiking, biking, golf, yachting and visits to natural, cultural and archaeological sites. The country is one of the most popular winter destinations in the Balkans with its major ski resorts Bansko, Borovets and Pamporovo.

The healing power of mineral springs has been used since the time of the Thracians and the Romans. With more than 600 healing mineral thermal springs, healing climate and curative mud, Bulgaria is a competitive and medical spa destination. Mineral springs located in the southern part of the country are influenced by the Mediterranean climate, other springs are also located in mountain regions and along the Black Sea coast.
