Dear Taoiseach,

I would like to thank you for your participation at the COSAC meeting in Dublin on 24 June and for your contribution to the success of the overall event, which was central to the parliamentary dimension to the Irish Presidency, and the final in a series of eight interparliamentary conferences hosted by the Oireachtas during that period.
