To: the JPSG Co-Chairs and the delegations of the National Parliaments and the European Parliament to the JPSG on Europol

The matter: Proposed amendments to the Rules of Procedure of the Joint Parliamentary Scrutiny Group on Europol.

Prior to the fifth meeting of the Joint Parliamentary Scrutiny Group on Europol (JPSG) and the scheduled discussion on the review of the Rules of Procedure and the designation of the JPSG representative to the meetings of the Europol Management Board, the Riksdag delegation to the JPSG would like to propose amendments to the Rules of Procedure's provisions on the appointment of the JPSG's representative to the Management Board of Europol (Article 5) and the final provisions on entry into force and revision of the Rules of Procedure (Article 6).

Regarding Article 5 on the appointment of the JPSG's representative to the Europol Management Board, the Riksdag delegation considers that there is reason to establish an automatic order for who is to represent the JPSG as an observer at the meetings of the Europol Management Board. It seems unreasonable that the JPSG delegations should devote time and energy before every meeting to prepare their positions on various candidates. An automatic order would also separate the appointment from the issue of the JPSG's decisionmaking rule (consensus rule). The proposal would mean that the assignment as observer would become an integrated part of the responsibilities as rotating Co-Chair. The assignment as observer would thus rotate in a way that gives the delegations of the national Parliaments an equal opportunity to form their own opinion of what the task involves and to get an insight into how the Europol Management Board works. These reasons carry greater weight than the argument that insight into the Management Board's work would benefit from the assignment as observer being held by one and the same person for a longer period.

Regarding **Article 6** on the final provisions on entry into force and revision of the Rules of Procedure, the Riksdag delegation to the JPSG considers that the entry into force provision (Article 6.1) should be changed so that amendments to the Rules of Procedure only enter into force a while after they have been adopted.

This is to avoid the risk that amendments affect the procedures for consideration of any items on the agenda after their adoption.

Political scrutiny of Europol through the JPSG is a new phenomenon. It is natural that the JPSG needs to explore and test the procedures for its activities, and that all situations cannot be predicted. It may therefore be necessary to take an evolutionary approach to the Rules of Procedure, where tested, functioning routines are successively added and less well-functioning provisions are removed or amended. For this reason, a special procedure should be introduced in Article 6.2 regarding proposals for amendments to the Rules of Procedure and consideration of such proposals, in addition to the opportunity given to delegations to send documents to the Co-Chairs relating to items on the agenda pursuant to Article 4.6.2 of the Rules of Procedure.

Furthermore, the revision clause should be replaced as it will become obsolete in view of the time frame it sets out.

Please find enclosed our proposed amendments to the said articles.
