


**Proposed amendment to the JPSG Rules of Procedure,
as approved by the EP Delegation to the JPSG on 17 April 2019 and on 3 September
2019**

<p>ARTICLE 5: REPRESENTATIVE TO THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF EUROPOL</p> <p>The JPSG shall appoint, from its full Members, a representative who will be entitled to attend, in accordance with Article 14 of the Europol Regulation and for a duration determined by the JPSG, meetings of the Management Board of Europol as a non-voting observer. The representative shall report back to the JPSG after each meeting of the Management Board on his/her main findings in writing.</p>	<p>ARTICLE 5: REPRESENTATIVE TO THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF EUROPOL</p> <p>The JPSG shall appoint <i>by consensus</i>, from its full Members, a representative who will be entitled to attend, in accordance with Article 14 of the Europol Regulation and for a duration determined by the JPSG <i>of eighteen months, which can be extended by six months</i>, meetings of the Management Board of Europol as a non-voting observer. The representative shall report back to the JPSG after each meeting of the Management Board on his/her main findings in writing.</p>
