

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies
On the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament and the Council
Shaping the Conference on the Future of Europe**

COM(2020) 27

The Chamber of Deputies welcomes the initiative of the European Commission to prepare a conference on the future of the European Union, calling for an active, direct participation of national parliaments and all Union political forces.

As regards the topics to be discussed, the Chamber of Deputies emphasises the importance of education, which should not be neglected in the context of the dual environmental and digital transition, the improvement of public control over the use of funding for scientific research, and the strengthening of participation in research and innovation programmes funded by the European Commission.

On the other hand, the Chamber of Deputies points out that the organisation of participation in the conference's work should ensure that citizens' views are processed, taking into account the disparities between Member States regarding the involvement of senior citizens in the process.
